JJ Lee wrote the memoir *The Measure of a Man: The Story of a Father, a Son, and a Suit*. It was a finalist for the Governor General's Literary Award for Nonfiction, the Hilary Weston Writer's Trust Prize, the Charles Taylor Prize, and the BC Book Prize's Hubert Evans Award.

In 2012 his short feature, "You are beautiful", received a GOLD at the National Magazine Awards.
