As co-editor, she helped put out Shale: Extreme Fiction for Extreme Conditions, an anthology of short fiction (Texture Press). Fox received graduate degrees from Temple University (Philadelphia) and Binghamton University and currently teaches at Drexel University in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania where she is a writing fellow with Writers Room. In addition to teaching writing, including creative writing, she teaches a "Small Press Development" course with Drexel's Masters in Publishing program. Previously she has taught at Peirce College (Philadelphia), Senzoku Gakuen (Kawasaki, Japan), and Sophia University (Tokyo). She currently lives in central New Jersey with her family.
